William J. Young built
the first precision
graduating machine in this
country which made possible
the precision surveying
instruments, and also
invented the transit instru-
ment. His sons continued
the businesses until 1918.
This instrument is a fine
example of the workmanship
of this old American company
which contributed so much
to instrument development.

instructions. The round table
is 12" in diameter. The
main scale reads in degrees
of azimuth and the small dial
in hundredths. An ordnance
