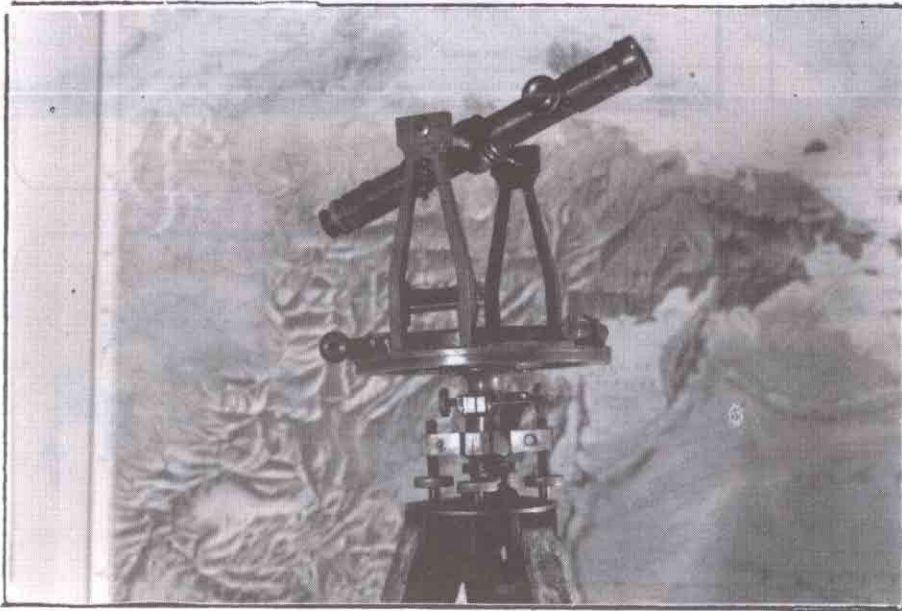

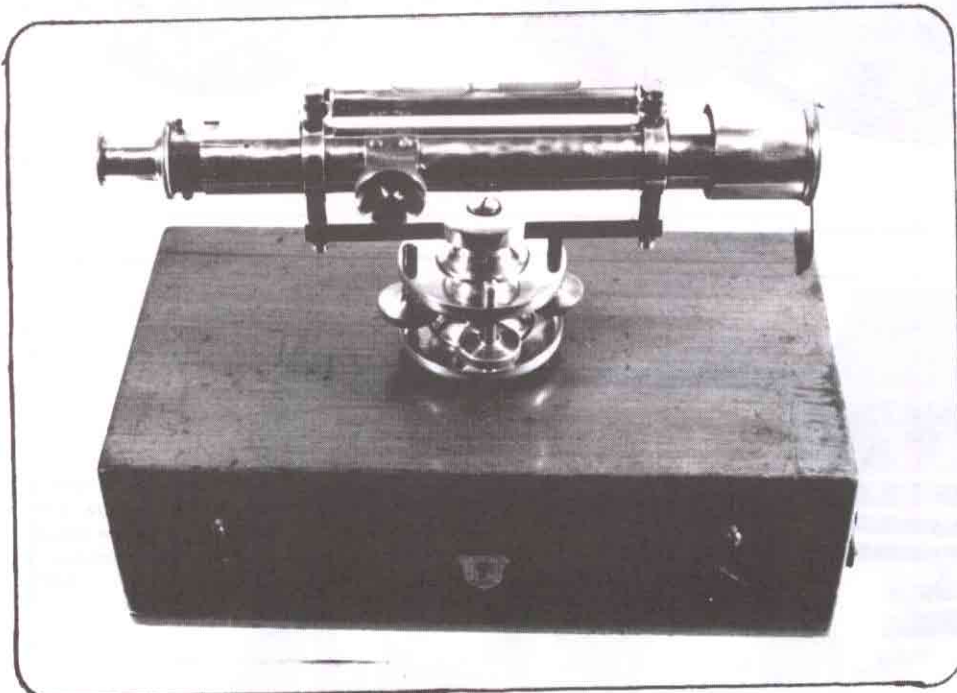
WE HAVE MOVED
