Description

"The Makers of Surveying Instruments in America Since 1700" by Charles E. Smart, Chairman of the Board of Directors W.& L.E. Gurley. This is a fine complete set of the original 2 volume printing, published in 1962 & 1967 by the Regal Art Press. Volume I has 182 pages; Volume 2 has pages 182-282. The book covers virtually all of the major American surveying instrument makers, with dates of working, shop addresses, types of instruments made, illustrations of trade labels, etc. Probably the most important reference book for the American surveying instrument collector, very long out-of-print (even the later reprint is out-of-print and very seldom seen). We have not had a copy of the original or the reprint in our catalog stock for nearly 5 years, and even back then the reprint sold for over \$250.
